The Open Final

The CUMMINGS team were 24th at the halfway stage, then scored 25, 23, 22, 23, 22 to hit the lead with a round to go, fittingly playing MARSTON in the final round (Seeds 1 & 2), winning 19-11.

In the final they would meet ANTOFF, who were at the top tables the whole way.

The 64-board final began at 9am yesterday with one member of the CUMMINGS team still in bed (hint: he lives nearby). This meant a 6 IMP fine with worse to follow at the table.

ANTOFF jumped out to a 54 IMP lead in the first set and were never headed. Here are two hands from that set:

Just a thought for the SpNOT:

After 10 rounds of Swiss, top 4 play semi-finals (32 boards) while others continue Swiss. (Like Surfers)

Also, the Swiss Pairs in Tasmania would be less of a lottery if the format of the Dick Cummings Pairs were followed, i.e., sit in same direction for qualifying rounds and have top 8 / 9 pairs in each direction qualify for a final. Event could start with Rounds 1-2 on Friday, 3-7 on Saturday, final + Swiss continuation on Sunday. That would bring some quality into the event.



Parking

Signing in

You will usually need to sign in each time you arrive at the club.

Smoking

The smoking area at the Hakoah Club is on the ground floor, in the gaming area.

Mobile phones must be switched off in the playing area. A procedural penalty of 3 VPs (or 9 IMPs) applies to any player whose mobile phone is switched on unless the director determines that there is a valid (e.g. medical) reason.
