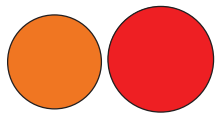

## 9. CONVENTIONS

**Unusual NT:** Lower 2 unbid suits

**4th Suit Forcing** One round  Game force

**NT Checkback**  Priorities: 2♣ forces 2♦: and 2♦=GF

**Defence to 3NT opening** : X=penalty

**Defence to Opening Twos** X=T/O with Lebensohl, Leaping Michaels

Multi 2♦ Direct seat: X=12+hcp subsequent X=T/O: 2NT=16-18 with stoppers

RCO style 2-s X=12+; bids are natural.

Other 2-s 12+hcp X or bid 5c suit
